

Rules & Guidelines For Selling
(Watch Our How To Video On Our Website)

1. Your price tag must have your seller # written/typed out on the left hand upper corner. The price of your item must be written/typed out on the right bottom corner. Use \$ sign and price. If you are not participating in the half price sale then you must write/type FIRM on your sale sticker. Make sure to use a strong tag or tape over your tag. Painters tape, colored small circle tags fall off very easily. Remember 100's of hands or touching your items. Do Not use a piece of paper and then use a small piece of scotch tape over it. Check your price tags a couple days after you price them to ensure they are still attached.
2. Remove all old rummage sale stickers. No marking out old prices/seller # and rewriting a new price/seller #. You must use a new tag. All items must be priced at least \$1 or more. No FREE items. If it's not worth a \$1 then sell like items together. All items must be priced in at least quarter increments no .49 or .99 cents. No boxes of items that say each item \$1 etc. Each item must be priced. Do not use rubber bands, paper clips etc to bundle items as they will come undone. If bundling items together they must be in a sealed stapled/taped shut bag/box. Single items do not need to be in a bag. You can put seller tags directly on items that are single.
3. If selling fabric use a safety pin or double staple the price tag. All boxes/bags/containers must be sealed shut with tape or staple. If items are inside a tackle box/box etc it must be taped shut. If someone can open up the item and things fallout then it will be donated. A bag of markers/stamps etc must be taped or stapled shut. Paper Pumpkin boxes must be taped shut. Taping bags/boxes or stapling them prevents people from opening them up and removing items/placing other items inside.
4. When bringing items in to sell they must be brought in non returnable boxes/bags. *If bringing items in on the Saturday drop off date all items must be brought in stackable shut boxes. NO BAGS OR ITEMS NOT IN STACKABLE BOXES. You do not need to tape the boxes shut they just need to be closed. You will be loading your items onto a trailer and stacking your boxes if bringing in on this Saturday drop off date. Do Not write your name/seller # on your boxes/bags. You will not be getting your unsold items in the same boxes/bags you bring your items back in. If bringing items in on other dates than Saturday they do not need to be in stackable boxes and can be brought in bags. All items must be brought in something to contain them. No bringing items in and dumping them out.
5. When you drop off your items please bring with you the filled out Sellers Information Sheet that is on our website. All items you bring in that do not meet our sales criteria will automatically be donated. Daisy Lane is not responsible for lost, stolen or damaged items.
6. We are excited to hold a sale where you can find new homes for your items while making some extra cash. We do accept the refills for all Xyron machines. All items must fit the categories of Craft Supplies, Party Supplies, Office Supplies or Organizing.
